### PRESIDENT'S SELECT WINE FEATURES

**Sileni Cellar Selection Sauvignon Blanc– New Zealand – 2010** **10 40**

Ripe tropical and gooseberry fruit flavours with a zingy finish and impeccable balance.

**Langtry Estate Guenoc Lake County Cabernet Sauvignon – California – 2009** **10 40**

Aromas of cassis, cocoa, plum, dark chocolate and cherry. Dry, intense with lots of fruit and tannin to match. Medium-full bodied with a substantial finish.

### LOCAL WINERIES

**Colchester Ridge VQA Riesling - 2009** **28**

A crisp pear nose leads into a surprisingly smooth and delicately sweet mouth-feel. The taste is reminiscent of mandarin oranges while the balanced acids result in a clean finish, with lingering pecan.

**Colchester Ridge VQA Cabernet Sauvignon – 2008** **32**

Enjoy this full bodied red with dinner or a dark chocolate treat. A delight to savour on its own, the finish is buttery, smooth and lasting.

**Aleksander Estate VQA Baco Noir – Ruthven – 2010** **32**

Offers both depth in colour and flavour. A full-bodied dry wine that is intense with dark berry undertones and black pepper aromas.

**Aleksander Estate VQA Chardonnay – Ruthven – 2010** **32**

The unoaked Chardonnay is full-bodied and dry combining red apple, rose water and honey notes with a soft finish.

**Viewpointe Estate VQA Auxerrois - 2009** **33**

Aromas of pineapple with a touch of spice with exotic fruit flavors and a crisp finish.

**Viewpointe Estate VQA Cabernet/Merlot - 2006** **30**

Aromas of Cassis, black cherry, black currant, spice, pepper and dark chocolate. The palate Shows moderate tannins and nice acidity notes of spice with a long finish.

## RED WINES

### MALBEC

- B1 **Trapiche Reserve Malbec– Argentina - 2010** 28  
Sweet aromas of blackberries and plums with an elegant touch of smoke and vanilla.
- B2 **Andeluna Malbec Reserva - Mendoza, Argentina - 2008** 43  
Big, bold blackberry fig and coffee flavours with hints of licorice and barrel smoke. Giant finish for a Malbec

### MERLOT

- B3 **Wyndham Estate Bin 999 – Australia - 2010** 32  
Garnet colour; blackberry, cherry and plum aromas with light oak; ripe fruit flavours, soft tannin and an oaky finish.
- B4 **Brownstone Vineyards – California – 2008** 36  
Solid blackberry fruit and smoke with a mellow soft and round finish.
- B5 **Freemark Abbey – Napa Valley – 2008** 62  
Aged in French and American oak barrels to develop hints of spice and flavors including espresso, dried cranberry, chocolate and mint.

### SHIRAZ

- B6 **Wyndham Estate Bin 555 – Australia - 2008** 32  
A rich, full bodied wine showing powerful berry fruit flavours; plums, dark cherries with slight lifted spice characters are evident.
- B8 **Casillero Del Diablo – Concha Y Toro - Chile – 2010** 36  
This toasty red showcases loads of blackberry and wood smoke. Perfect partner with filet, duck and fire grilled rack of lamb.
- B10 **Dog Ridge Vineyards– McLaren Vale - Australia - 2006** 70  
Bright red. Raspberry and boysenberry on the nose. Berry fruit harmonizes with fine-grained tannins and succulent herbs on the finish.

### ZINFANDEL

- Beringer (Rose) – California – 2010** 28  
Served chilled and compliments a variety of cuisine such as grilled chicken, pasta salads as well as spicy dishes.
- B12 **Ravenswood Vintners Blend - California – 2009** 38  
Aromas of spice, black raspberry and mocha. Soft and round with fruit and cocoa flavors.
- B14 **Frog's Leap Vineyards- Napa Valley – 2008** 70  
Offers lush layers of wild raspberry and mulberry underscored with a touch of cinnamon and white pepper. The tannins are polished and the texture is plush.

## CABERNET SAUVIGNON

B15	<b>Wyndham Estate Bin 444 – Australia – 2007</b> Ripe blackcurrant and cabernet flavours combine with delicate chocolate/smoky oak. Grape and oak tannins are harmonized to provide a lingering, but soft, structured finish.	32
B16	<b>Michael Sullberg Reserve - California – 2010</b> Nicely layered with plenty of forward fruit, a medium body and moderate tannins.	36
B17	<b>Marques Casa Concha – Maipo - Chile – 2008</b> Black cherry aromas and fig flavour with hints of vanilla and coffee.	38
B19	<b>J. Lohr Seven Oaks – California – 2009</b> Aromatic bouquet of cherry, blueberry, violets and vanilla. Full bodied, balanced with firm tannins.	44
B20	<b>Heavyweight Red – Lodi – California – 2009</b> Very pleasant, well-rounded cabernet with some oak and chocolate undertones.	45
B21	<b>Sterling – Napa Valley California – 2008</b> This wine is bold and flavoured with rich aromas of cassis, plum and hints of chocolate.	65
B22	<b>Beringer Estate - Knights Valley – California – 2008</b> Displays aromas of plums, cocoa, blackcurrant, sweet cherry and cedar. Medium, full-bodied with a long fruit/tannin finish.	90
B23	<b>Atlas Peak – California – 2005</b> Big, firm tannins that are refined and smooth. Providing a rich structure to the massively concentrated blackberries, blueberries, cherries and sweet, smoky oak.	160

## PINOT NOIR

B24	<b>Stoneleigh – New Zealand - 2010</b> Fragrant bouquet of red berry fruit with savoury spice from French oak. Soft supple Palate with lingering sweetness balanced with fine velvety tannins.	38
B25	<b>Amity Vineyards – Oregon, USA – 2008</b> Red and black cherry leaves combine with a pleasant nose for a smooth silky wine.	48
B26	<b>Gloria Ferrier – Etesian – Sonoma County – California – 2007</b> Brimming with soft ripe strawberry, cherry and vanilla. Brilliant food matcher!	53

## ITALIAN REDS

B28	<b>La Ghera Piage Rossi Barbera d'Asti - Moasca – 2009</b> A bit floral, violets, no overt wood with good complexity of flavor and concentration of black pepper and sweet plump ripe black cherry.	40
B29	<b>Rocca delle Macie Chianti Riserva – Tuscany- 2007</b> Intense and fine, with evident fruit and a pleasant spicy note, it is notable for its rich, lasting flavour and well integrated tannins.	42
B30	<b>Tommasi Valpolicella Superiore Ripasso – Pedemonte - 2009</b> Rich spicy black pepper nose with a hint of raisins. Full bodied and spicy with sweet cherry flavors.	45
B31	<b>Fontanafredda - Barolo – 2005</b> Dry, full-bodied vintage, austere but velvety, recalls dried roses, licorice and spices.	60
B33	<b>Tedeschi - Amarone - 2006</b> The sweet port like aromas of chocolate and plum are very invite robust food choices	80

## SPANISH REDS

- B34 **Darien Crianza Rioja– Spain – 2007** 42  
Well balanced with red berry and cherry flavors. Aged in French and American oak for one year adding notes of smoke and toast.

## FRENCH REDS

- B35 **Chateau Lagrange - Bourdeaux - 2008** 50  
This Merlot-dominated wine features aromas of cherry, raspberry, blueberry, spice and cedar. Dry with good replays supported by solid tannins. This durable, well-balanced wine has an attractively spicy fruit finish.
- B36 **Chateau Montmirail Vacqueryras - Rhone - 2008** 62  
Medium to full bodied with ripe red fruit, hints of licorice and baking spices. Long balanced finish.
- B37 **La Fiole du Pape – France -** 80  
Rich colour and a spicy bouquet combined with a fruity palate and a complex finish.
- B38 **Chateau Cayrou – Cahors Cru D’Exception – France- 2000** 85  
French malbec at it’s richest and darkest; opaque berry fruit toasty Bordeaux finish.

## WHITE WINES

### FRENCH WHITES

- B39 **Willy Gisselbrecht Gewurztraminer- Alsace, France - 2008** 45  
Pleasant notes of peach, ginger and lychee greet the nose. A touch off-dry, well balanced and lovely with citrus, peach and spice tones.
- B40 **Chateau Gaudrelle Vouvray- Vouvray, France - 2009** 52  
Medium bodied with crisp citrus and ripe pear. Finishing dry with hints of melon.

### SAUVIGNON BLANC

- B43 **Marisco Vineyards– New Zealand – 2010** 42  
Bursting with zesty citrus and capsicum floral flavors. Well balanced with good acidity.
- B44 **Cloudy Bay – New Zealand– 2008** 60  
Pale straw green in colour and enticingly fragrant offering lifted aromas of ripe stonefruit and juicy citrus with underlying notes of blackcurrant leaf and tomato plant spice.

### CHARDONNAY

- B45 **Wyndham Estate Bin 222 – Australia – 2010** 32  
Creamy soft apple and banana aromas softened with light toasty oak barrel flavours.
- B46 **J. Lohr – Riverstone – Monterey County – California – 2010** 36  
Nectarine and butterscotch nose, rich vanilla hazelnut palate. Seafood heaven.
- B47 **Oyster Bay – New Zealand - 2010** 40  
Unoaked chardonnay with aromas and flavors of green apple, ripe peach, vanilla, light toasted oak and tropical fruit.

### ARGENTINIAN WHITES

- B49 **Andeluna Torrontes– Argentina – 2011** 32  
Excellent balance of fruit notes and acidity. Aromas of jasmine, peach, apricot and grapefruit with hints of spice and minerality.

	A full and intense scent, rich in ripe fruit, floral and mineral notes. Dry and fresh with a strong personality. It is harmonic and of good structure. Ideal with light first courses and smoked salmon.	
B52	<b>Santa Margherita Pinot Grigio - Italy – 2010</b>	36
	Aromas of fresh green apple, lime and peach that replay beautifully on the palate and cleansing finish.
